DOES e-BRIDGE® GLOBAL PRINT SUPPORT MULTI-FACTOR AUTHENTICATION (MFA)?

e-BRIDGE® Global Print uses modern OAuth standards to log in users via one of our supported third-party authentication providers (e.g., Microsoft® identity platform, Google Identity). This means that when a user signs in, they are re-directed to the identity provider to validate the sign-in credentials, and then are re-directed back to e-BRIDGE® Global Print.

This means that if multi-factor authentication is enabled for a user in the third-party authentication provider, the user will need to follow the normal steps to complete each authentication.
